

Checklist to Earn Class D, Provisional (under 21) License

Phase 1: Classroom

- Register for Driver Education classroom course
 - Successfully complete 30 hour course and receive Certificate of Enrollment (blue card) from instructor
 - Take permit exam (knowledge and vision) at exam station - <https://dps.mn.gov/divisions/dvs/online-self-services/Pages/default.aspx> for hours and locations of permit/license exam station. You will need to schedule an appointment for this test.
- ***Parent must be present to sign their permission to issue permit. Must have 2 forms of ID (see acceptable list on mndriveinfo.org), Certificate of Enrollment (blue card), social security number and fee.

Phase 2: Driving with permit

Once you have your permit, you are allowed to drive with a parent or another licensed driver age 21 or older (with parent's permission) seated in the passenger seat.

During the permit phase, students must keep a written log showing a minimum of 50 practice hours in order to be licensed. By law, *a student must set up their first driving lesson within 90 days of receiving their permit, schedule the 1st of 3 behind the wheel lessons (please book online at aplusdrivingschool.net) ***please make sure to pick the proper area/location for lesson*

Please log approximately 25 practice hours between lessons and plan on scheduling one lesson at a time. Please don't wait until the last minute to schedule multiple lessons, spread them out over a minimum of 6 months.

- Student must practice 25 hours between lessons (please record on supervised driving log). 15 of the practice hours should be at night
- Schedule road test 6-8 weeks in advance at: mndriveinfo.org
- Book driving lesson 3 six weeks before scheduled road test

- Receive Certificate of Completion (white card) from instructor upon completion of 3rd behind the wheel lesson

Phase 3: Provisional License

- Bring permit, social security number, white card, license fee and supervised driving log to testing station
- When you pass road test parent must be present to sign permission

BEHIND THE WHEEL SCHEDULING

Driving with permit- Once student has a permit, they are allowed to drive with a parent or another licensed driver age 21 or older (with parent permission) seated in passenger seat. During the permit phase, students must keep a [Driving Log](#) showing a minimum of 50 practice hours in order to be licensed. *Within 3 months of receiving permit, schedule 1st behind the wheel lesson*

(please book online at aplusdrivingschool.net) **Book Now**. DO NOT WAIT UNTIL THE LAST MINUTE TO SET UP BTW LESSONS. DO NOT WAIT UNTIL SPRING/SUMMER TO SET UP MULTIPLE LESSONS. LESSONS SHOULD BE SPREAD OUT OVER THE 6 MONTHS A STUDENT HAS A PERMIT TO INSURE THEY ARE SAFE AND COMFORTABLE WITH WHAT IS BEING COVERED ON EACH LESSON. STUDENTS MAY ONLY SET UP ONE LESSON AT A TIME.

When your child is ready for lesson 2 (able to do lane changes, determine right-of way, turn, stop, back up, modulate appropriate speed, and keep at least 3-second following distance without assistance)

When your child is ready for lesson 3: able to do lane changes, determine right-of way, turn, stop, back up, modulate appropriate speed, keep at least 3-second following distance without assistance has full awareness and appropriate reactions to potential and actual hazards and is ready/has enough confidence to drive in unfamiliar urban settings, merge without assistance and 99% of the time needs no assistance from parent while driving and has logged 50-100 hours of driving:

Book driving lesson 3 (4-6 weeks prior to road test)

Receive Certificate of Completion (white card) from instructor upon completion of 3rd behind the wheel lesson

Phase 3: Provisional License

Bring permit, social security number, certificate of completion (“white card”), license fee, proof of vehicle insurance and supervised driving log to testing station
