809 PARKING AND TRAFFIC REGULATIONS

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to maintain safe and secure parking at ISD 719 facilities.

II. DEFINITION

III. GENERAL STATEMENT OF POLICY

1. Only those vehicles belonging to students or employees of Independent School District 719 or to other persons having a purpose or function at the schools may park on school property.
2. Parking is prohibited on school district roadways, sidewalks, landscaped areas, safety zones, loading zones, within five (5) feet of intersections, adjacent to yellow curbs and in areas where parking is expressly prohibited by signs. Exceptions to this regulation are as follows:
 - A. School district owned vehicles, when being used in the performance of work on school district property.
 - B. Vehicles making delivery of goods to the schools may park in the loading zones during required delivery time.
3. Parking in a restricted area shall be limited to those persons who have been issued a special permit for parking in a restricted area. Special permits are issued by the building principal in the form of a card or sticker which must be displayed when the vehicles are parked in the restricted area.
4. Parking lanes are designated by painted lines or post indicators during winter. Parking is restricted to a maximum of one parking space per vehicle. Parking on lane lines or parking in a position which occupies more than one parking space is prohibited.
5. Maximum speed of vehicles on school property shall be ten (10) miles per hour unless indicated by posted signs.
6. Driving of autos and other vehicles is restricted to roadways surfaced with blacktop or gravel. The driving or parking of autos and other vehicles on lawns, athletic fields or other grass surfaced or landscaped areas is prohibited unless authorized by Operations for special events. District owned vehicles used in the performance of maintenance or repair are exceptions.

7. Exhibition driving is prohibited. No person shall turn, accelerate, de-accelerate or otherwise operate a motor vehicle on school property in a manner which causes unnecessary engine noise or backfire, squealing tires, skidding, sliding, swaying, throwing of sand or gravel or in a manner simulating a race. Squealing or screeching sounds emitted by tires or the throwing of sand or gravel by the tires is considered evidence of a violation of this provision.
8. The dumping or depositing of any refuse on school property is prohibited.
9. The regulatory provisions of Minnesota Statute, as amended, are hereby adopted as traffic regulations controlling the use of parking facilities, roadways and property owned, leased occupied or operated by Independent School District 719.
10. No person shall drive or operate all-terrain vehicles on property owned, leased, occupied or operated by Independent School District 719 with the exception of such vehicles owned by the district and operated by district staff.
11. Visitors parking during school hours are limited to designated areas.

Penalties for Violations

1. Loss of parking privileges for a stipulated period if a person violates the rules. Vehicles may also be towed at owners expense for violation of parking privileges.
2. Any person violating the rules and regulations in the shall be guilty of a petty misdemeanor and shall be subject to the provisions as detailed in Minnesota Statute.
3. Continual and willful violations of these parking regulations by students will result in suspension of driving privileges, suspension from school or other disciplinary action.
