



ISD 719 POOL RENTAL INFORMATION

In order to rent the pool, certain criteria needs to be met:

1. Community pool requests require certified lifeguards and supervisors employed by ISD 719. With advance notice, lifeguards can be hired through the district if available. Facility user groups may provide their own certified lifeguards with prior approval from the Aquatics Coordinator or the facility use office. There must be a certified lifeguard at each pool requested. The certifications must be current and received before approval of a request is given.
2. Facility user groups that frequently use pool space will be required to receive instruction on use of pool covers. Instruction can be arranged through the facility use office or Aquatics Coordinator
 - a. Pool covers are to be removed by the first facility user of any given day and replaced as directed. Pool schedules will be made available to those using the pool.
 - b. If the request is for a swimming invitational, the cover may be removed at the start of the invitational, and replaced at the completion.
 - c. Rules for operation of pool covers are posted along with pool rules at each site.
3. Use of the diving well for swimming is permitted, but there must be a certified lifeguard present and no use of the diving boards is permitted. It is recommended with the depths of the diving well to only use experienced swimmers. If the request is for diving, a lifeguard certified for diving is required.
4. Spot checks may be administered to make sure that pool rules are being followed. If it is found that these rules are not being met, a district employee may be required to be present during future use at the user's expense or further use may be denied.
5. Proof of insurance must also be provided before use is permitted.
6. The number of Lifeguards required is according to the following table:

1 to 50 patrons.....	2 lifeguards
51-75 patrons.....	3 lifeguards
76 to 120 patrons.....	4 lifeguards + 1 supervisor
121 to 160 patrons.....	5 lifeguards + 1 supervisor
161 to 210 patrons.....	6-7 lifeguards + 1 supervisor
7. Lifeguard and/or supervisor fees will be charged at the current hourly rate of compensation plus 15 minute set-up and 15 minute clean-up times built in around the requested times.
8. The group must also provide one adult supervisor per 25 patrons.
9. ISD #719 has the right to limit or cancel pool usage depending on how many lifeguards are available.
10. Rules are posted at pool entrance areas.
11. In addition to pool/locker room supervision fees, there is a building usage fee based on the school districts fee schedule for type and function of groups usage and a possible custodial overtime fee assessed at the current contracted rate when the building is not normally open.

POOL RULES

Obey all posted rules

(SEE BOARD POLICY 902)

Non and poor swimmers must stay at the shallow end(s) of the pool and go no further than chest deep water!! See the respective diagram on the reverse side.

1. Swimmers suspected of having a communicable disease are prohibited from entering the pool.
2. Swimmers must take a cleansing shower using warm water and soap and thoroughly rinse off all soap before entering the pool enclosure. If leaving the pool to use the toilet swimmers must take a second cleansing shower before returning to the pool enclosure.
3. Swimmers with any considerable area of exposed sub-epidermal tissue, open blisters, or cuts are prohibited from entering the pool.
4. No running, (no two steps running or dangerous jumping – spinning, flips, etc. into groups) or rough play in the pool, in locker rooms or shower rooms, on runways, on the diving board or on platforms.
5. Supervised waters sports are permitted in the pool.
6. At TO jumping into the pool is permitted only between the flags. At HO, jumping into the pool is permitted only in the deep area of the pool.
7. No pushing or dunking.
8. No diving except in diving permissible areas.
9. No hanging on to the pool buoys/lane lines.
10. Must be able to swim one length of the pool before allowed in deep water.
11. Food, beverages, gum, or tobacco products are not allowed in the pool or spectator areas.
12. No glassware or similar material with a tendency to shatter on impact is allowed in the pool enclosure area.

DIVING REGULATIONS

The 3 meter board at HOMS is off limits!!

1. One person on the board, one bounce and one person in the water at a time. At TO the diver must swim straight across to the ladder to exit; second diver must stay off the board until the first diver reaches the opposite. At HO, the diver must exit the ladder on the left by the Pool Office.
2. Dive only straight off the front end of the board.
3. No large splash, dangerous or exhibition type diving allowed.
4. No swimming in the diving area.
5. No diving out of control.

POOL COVER INSTRUCTIONS

1. Only persons instructed on how to operate the pool cover should remove and replace it.
2. No portion of the cover should be left on the pool while the pool is in use.
3. Do no walk on the pool cover.
4. The pool cover should not be operated when patrons are under or around the covers.
5. All equipment including lane markers and flags should be removed before putting the pool cover on.
6. If issues occur when operating the cover, please find a custodian to assist.
7. For Hidden Oaks pool, both covers must be operated as one.

SAFETY EQUIPMENT/SWIMMING EQUIPMENT

1. Safety equipment (Rescue tube, ring bouy) should only be used in an emergency.
2. If Safety equipment is used, it must be returned to its original placement.
3. Swimming equipment must be returned to the storage closet and put back where it needs to be stored (not dropped on the floor or in the wrong crate/shelf).

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
